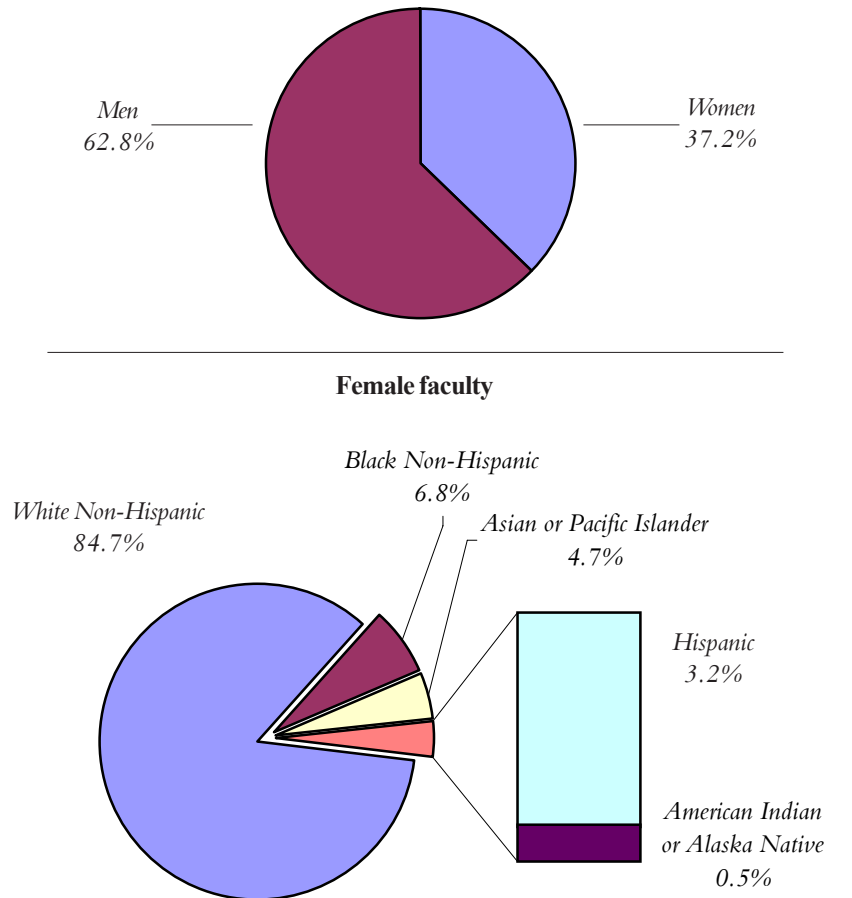


Figure 2-7 • Full-time faculty in institutions of higher education by sex, and by race and Hispanic origin of the women, fall 1998¹

As of late 1999, men accounted for more than three in every five full-time faculty members in institutions of higher education. Of the approximately 214,000 women in such positions whose race and/or ethnicity were reported, close to 85 percent were non-Hispanic whites.



¹The distribution by sex includes 7,190 non-resident aliens and 12,148 persons of unknown race or ethnicity. The distribution of the women by race and Hispanic origin omits those two categories.
