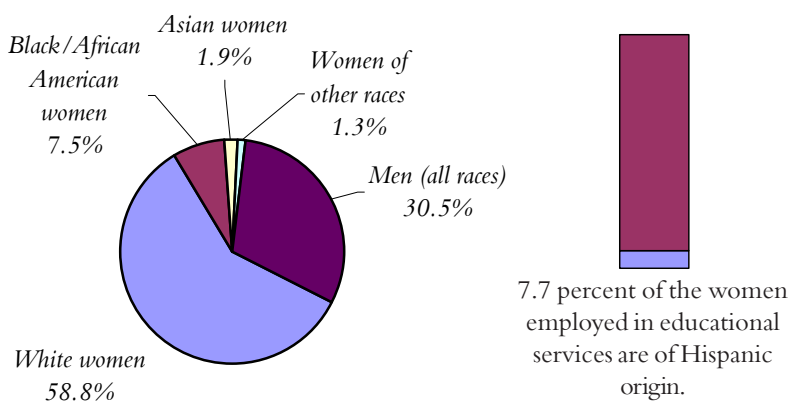


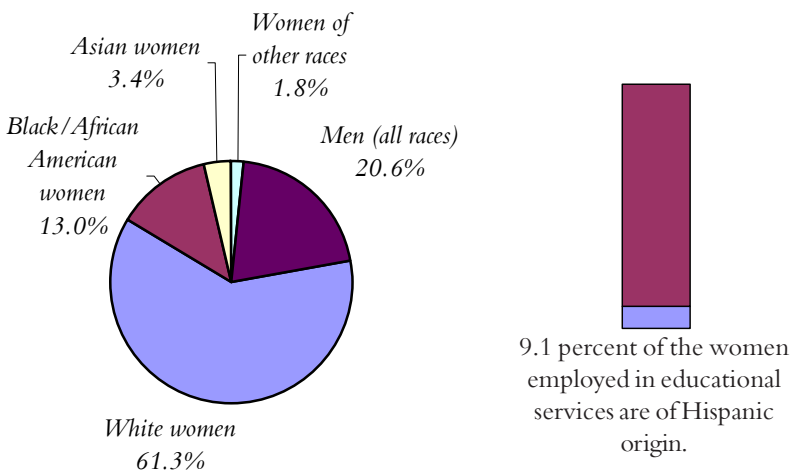
Figure 4-6 • People employed in the educational services and health care and social assistance industries, by sex, and by race and Hispanic origin of the women, 2003 (percent distributions)

Educational services and health care and social assistance are the two major sub-categories in the education and health services industry. Women not only predominate more heavily in health care and social assistance (nearly 80 percent) than in educational services (nearly 70 percent), but the representation of women of color is greater.
